#### **ENTRIES**

### **Entry Standards and Qualification Period**

The Entry Standards were approved by the IAAF Council in November 2016 (see Appendix D).

In accordance with the Technical Regulations, the qualification period runs from 1 October 2016 to 3 July 2017. In an attempt to help Member Federations, the deadline for submitting the Final Entries remains at three Mondays before the start of the Championships (as established by the Technical Regulations), i.e., 26 June 2017, but there will be an extended qualification period of one week.

This means that Member Federations must submit the athletes' names, including reserves, and all other relevant information (names of officials, travel details and accommodation needs) by 26 June 2017 but would be allowed to make any changes to the composition of their team up to one week later, i.e., until 3 July 2017. Please note that this is NOT an obligation but an option which some Member Federations may wish to take advantage of.

## **Entry Rules**

Only athletes aged 16 or 17 on 31 December 2017 (born in 2000 or 2001) may compete. Team Leaders must present athletes' passports upon arrival, or other official documents indicating the year of birth, to confirm ages and in order for them to be photocopied.

A maximum of two athletes from any one Member can compete in each event with the exception of the Relay (see below). Three athletes can initially be entered per event, provided each has achieved the Entry Standard but only two will be permitted to compete.

The maximum number of events that an athlete can compete in is two individual events plus the Relay. If the two individual events are Track Events, only one of these two individual races may be longer than 200m.

There are no entry standards for the 4x400m Mixed Relays so every Member may enter one team for the Mixed Relay race, composed of a maximum of three boys and three girls. Any four athletes (two boys and two girls) among those entered for the competition, whether for the Relay or for any other event, may then be used in the composition of the team for the first round. There is no fixed order of running and the order may be decided by each team at the time of the submission of the Final Declaration Form. Final Entries for the Relay shall be accepted until the Final Confirmation deadline.

#### Unqualified athletes

- Members who have no male and/or female qualified athletes whom they wish to enter in any Championships event, may enter one unqualified male athlete OR one unqualified female athlete in one event of the Championships (except the Field Events [see below] and Combined Events).
- Members who have no male and/or no female qualified athlete but whose best athlete excels in a field event, may submit to the IAAF, by the time of the Preliminary Entry deadline, the name of their athlete (plus performance) that they would like to enter in the Field Event. The Technical Delegates will make the final decision and, to do so, may seek the opinion of the relevant Area Association.
- Names of unqualified athletes must be submitted to the IAAF by 31 May 2017. If another
  athlete then achieves the Entry Standard before the end of the qualification period, it will be
  possible to change the entry accordingly.

If Kenya as the host country does not have an athlete qualified in an event, it may enter one athlete in this event regardless of any Entry Standard.

### Submission of Entries and deadlines

Preliminary Entries:

Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries on line using the IAAF on-line Event Entry System [http://evententry.iaaf.org] by 12 April 2017 midnight, Monaco time. Preliminary Entries may be submitted from 13 March 2017.

Final Entries: The Final Entries must also be submitted online using the IAAF

on-line Event Entry System (EES), by **26 June 2017** midnight, Monaco time (see note above). Final Entries may be submitted

from 29 May 2017.

Final Confirmations: Unless otherwise specified in the Team Manual, for events held

on 12 July, Final Confirmation of Entries must be made before 12 pm (midday) 11 July and, for all subsequent days, before 9 am on the day before the event. It will also be possible for Teams to confirm their athletes upon arrival during the accreditation

procedure at the Accreditation Centre.

#### Financial Penalties

Member Federations must respect the deadlines and provide accurate information in their entries in order to avoid financial implications for the LOC. Failure to do so may result in the application of financial penalties as detailed below. The penalties will be debited to the account of the Member held with the IAAF.

Respect of Deadlines A penalty of \$1,000 USD may be imposed on any Member which does not respect the Preliminary and/or Final Entry deadlines.

Realistic Entries A penalty of \$1,000 USD per athlete, after the first two, may be imposed on Members which:

- their participation do not take part;
   after having entered the Preliminary Entries for more than
- after having entered the Preliminary Entries for more than two athletes, attend the competition with a number of athletes 25% or more higher or lower than the entered number.

#### Athlete Acknowledgement and Agreement

Each athlete competing in an IAAF World Athletics Series Competition must have an appropriately filled in and signed copy of the Athlete Acknowledgement and Agreement on file at the IAAF.

All athletes competing in the IAAF World U18 Championships must sign and submit this acknowledgement, as soon as possible, and ideally by no later than the Final Entry deadline of 26 June 2017.

IAAF Member Federations are obliged to submit one for each entered athlete, either by email to: <a href="mailto:athletes-agreement@iaaf.org">athletes-agreement@iaaf.org</a>. or any Athlete Acknowledgement and Agreement Form not received by the IAAF before the event will be collected at the time of the Accreditation procedure. The Athlete Acknowledgement and Agreement Form can be found in Appendix G.

Note: Athletes who have already submitted their Agreement do not need to send it again - see appropriate indication in the EES.

#### TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

#### Travel to Nairobi

The official airport is Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (IATA code: NBO).

Arrival in Nairobi should be on Monday, 10 July and departure on Monday, 17 July. For those teams planning to arrive prior to 10 July and/or leave after 17 July, they are advised to contact the LOC well in advance in order to secure the necessary accommodation outside of the official period.

All athletes and officials will be accommodated in the fully renovated student housing blocks. Accommodation will be in single rooms, with shared bathroom and toilet facilities.

The accommodation invoices will be based on the information (number of persons and arrival/departure details) provided on the Final Entries, with a tolerance of two persons.

Payment of extra costs can be made:

- by credit card: MasterCard, Visa
- in cash: US Dollars

Dedicated rooms for teams' physiotherapy staff and team meetings will be available at the University.

#### Team Leaders Site Visit / Training Camps

Member Federations interested in paying an individual Site Visit to Nairobi or in planning training camps prior to the IAAF World Under 18 Championships, are advised to contact the Kenyan Athletics Federation in order to explore the various possibilities.

## **FINANCIAL SUPPORT**

#### Quota

The Quota for the World U18 Championships corresponds to the number of finalists (top 8) in the 2015 World Youth Championships (relay teams count for two athletes) with a maximum quota of 20.

The detailed quota for Nairobi 2017 can be found in Appendix E.

### **Travel Support**

For athletes within the Quota, 100% of an economy class airline ticket from the Member Federation headquarters to the official airport in Nairobi will be paid for by the IAAF. These tickets will be issued preferably by the IAAF, provided Member Federations send their Preliminary Entries and Final Entries by the respective deadlines. If a Member Federation prefers to purchase the airline tickets, the costs of such tickets must be submitted online together with the Preliminary Entries and be approved by the IAAF beforehand. Only the approved travel costs will be reimbursed.

Travel costs of athletes outside of the Quota and of Officials will not be covered by the IAAF or the LOC.

## **Accommodation Support**

For athletes within the Quota, the IAAF/LOC will offer free accommodation during the official period (arrival, Monday 10 July – departure, Monday 17 July), for a maximum of seven nights.

#### Reimbursements

Reimbursements will be made by bank transfer after the competition.

If an athlete for whom the IAAF/LOC have provided financial support is on site but does not compete, the IAAF/LOC have the right to reclaim the travel and accommodation support.

#### **COMPETITION INFORMATION**

#### Stadium

The Championships will take place in the "Kasarani Stadium" in Nairobi. Opened in 1987 and renovated in 2012, the stadium will be equipped with a new Mondo Track for the 2017 Championships. It has a total seating capacity for 60,000 spectators.

#### Timetable

The Timetable was approved by the IAAF Council in November 2016 (see Appendix B).

#### **Implements**

Implements were approved by the Technical Delegates in July 2016 and the Official list of Implements is attached in Appendix C.

Additional Implements may be added to the approved list, if requested by Member Federations directly or by Manufacturers with the endorsement of a Member Federation, by February 28 2017, and if supplied to the LOC free of charge. All such implements must have IAAF certification and must be approved by the IAAF Technical Delegates. Four items of each implement must be supplied by the Member Federation or Manufacturer concerned and must be sent to the LOC by 31 May 2017 at the latest.

Personal Implements will also be allowed, providing that:

- they are readily identifiable and are IAAF certified
- they are not already on the Official List of Implements
- they have been checked for compliance with IAAF Rules
- they are made available to all the other competitors until the end of the Final

## **Technical Meeting**

As in the latest World Youth Championships, the plan is not to hold a formal Technical Meeting. Instead the Technical Delegates, together with the IAAF and LOC Competitions Staff, will make themselves available, on 11 July, to any team managers that wish to address any particular matters. This informal meeting will take place at the Kasarani Stadium during the delegations' stadium tour, starting from 12:45. Information on the progressions, starting heights and raising of the bars will be distributed through the Competition Information Desk at the Kenyatta University before the stadium tour.

#### Athletes' Uniform

Athletes shall participate in the uniform clothing approved by their Member Federation. The Medal Ceremony is considered part of the competition for this purpose. In accordance with IAAF Competition Rule 143.1 and the IAAF Advertising Regulations, athletes' competition vests should have the same colour on the front and back. Please refer to the latest IAAF Advertising Regulations which can be found on the IAAF Website in the publications section (link: https://www.iaaf.org/about-iaaf/documents/rules-regulations).

All Members Federations must bring their team uniform to the accreditation centre for inspection, during the accreditation procedure.

### **IAAF AND COMPETITION LOGO**

The use of all IAAF and Competition logos is possible only with the written permission from the IAAF. If you intend to use any of these logos for any purpose i.e. on any printed material, you must seek the IAAF's approval prior to their usage. Such request must be received by the IAAF (info@iaaf.org) prior to production of the material.

### DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with the IAAF Anti-Doping Regulations, under the supervision of the IAAF Medical/Anti-Doping Delegate. Additional tests for National or Area Records or for other purposes will be conducted at the request of the relevant Member Federation or Area Association. The costs, to be borne by the relevant Member Federation or Area Association, will be provided in the Team Manual.

### **INSURANCE**

All Member Federations are responsible for subscribing to an insurance policy that covers illness and/or injury to any members of their delegation and/or team travelling to and from IAAF competitions and during the event itself. Furthermore, proof of such insurance is now required in most cases to obtain visas, e.g., in the Schengen area.

Details of the IAAF insurance policy were outlined in Circular M/06/17 dated 25 January 2017.

### **VISAS**

Appendix F provides the list of IAAF Member Federations divided into three Visa categories:

- Category A: The countries whose citizens do not need a visa for Kenya;
- Category B: The countries whose citizens need a visa to enter Kenya and can receive it upon arrival;
- Category C: The countries identified by the Government of Kenya as being in special regions and which are required to meet specific visa procedures in order for the visa to be received upon arrival.

For category C, it will be possible to receive the visa on arrival and the LOC Visa coordinator will contact the Member Federations concerned once preliminary entries are submitted to a request copy of the bio data page of the applicants' passport and any additional specific information. This information will have to be provided no later than 19 June 2017.

Categories B and C need to complete the request form attached and submit it to the LOC by 19 June 2017 at the latest.

Athletes aged 16 (sixteen years old) visiting Kenya do not require visa.

## **CONDITIONS FOR VALIDITY OF PERFORMANCES**

- All performances must be achieved during the period 1 October 2016 to 3 July 2017
- All performances must be achieved during an official competition organised in conformity with IAAF Rules.
- All performances must be achieved during competitions organised or sanctioned by the IAAF, its Area Associations or its Member Federations. Thus, results achieved at school competitions must be certified by the Member Federation of the country in which the competition was organised.
- Performances achieved in mixed competitions in track events will not be accepted (except for Race Walks).
- Wind assisted performances (over 2m/sec) will not be accepted.
- **Indoor performances** will be accepted however, for the running events of 200m and over, performances achieved on **over-sized tracks** will not be accepted.
- In the case of race walks:
  - o Road performances (5km or 10km) shall be accepted
  - o Results achieved in competitions conducted with the "Pit Lane" Rule shall be accepted
